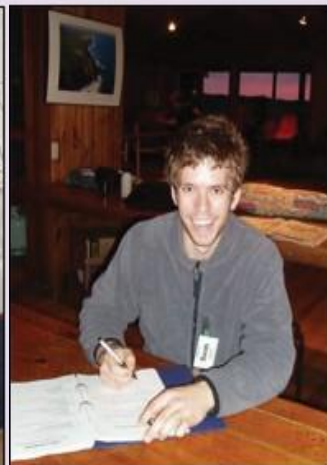
The RYLA program is **exciting, innovative** and **inspiring!** It is specifically tailored for young adults and encourages participation, fun and a high level of interactive learning.
