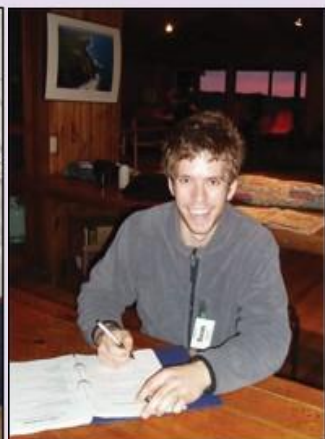
So who are the young people in or from your district originally?
